ANNOUNCEMENTS

Churches will reopen this Sunday!!!

We are happy to announce both St. Mary's and St. Anne's churches will be re-opening this Sunday, June 21st for all three Eucharistic celebrations. at the usual times – St. Mary's: Saturday Mass - 5 pm and Sunday 10:30 am; St. Ann's: Sunday 8:30 am

We are feverishly working with the guidelines shared by the Bishop to ensure we are clean and ready for your return. There are some MAJOR changes and some new protocols that we will be following as we reopen.

PLEASE be patient as we endeavour, in these unprecedented times, to ensure the safety of all parishioners. Listed below are a few important protocols that we will be following as we reopen:

1. Seating is limited! First come, first seated. Once we go over our numbers, unfortunately we will have to turn people away. St. Ann's will be able to accommodate approximately 26 people, while St. Mary's will be able to accommodate approximately 44 people safely. Please consider these numbers when choosing a mass time.
2. The wearing of a non-surgical mask is recommended for your protection and that of our fellow parishioners - children three are exempt and under and anyone with an underlying condition that prohibits the wearing of masks should consider staying home. Masks will NOT be provided by the church.
3. Outside the church, you will be greeted by an usher who will be tracking numbers and coordinating a safe entrance into the church. Please ensure your mask is in place when you reach this person.
4. The usher will direct you to a volunteer who will take your temperature. Please use the hand sanitizer provided.
5. This volunteer will direct you to the next usher who will assign you to your seat. Please follow their direction, even if you have your "normal" seat, we ask that you are flexible for the time being until all have become familiar with the procedures.
6. There will be no procession, no singing, no collection/offertory. The collection baskets are at the back of the church for you to deposit your offering when entering/exiting.
7. At communion and at the end of Mass, the usher will instruct you as to when you may leave your pew. PLEASE remain in your pew until instructed to process out.
8. When mass is over the usher will instruct you when it is safe for you to leave, pew by pew. Please do not stop at the back of the church but process all the way outside so as to avoid blocking a safe flow of traffic out. Please do not congregate in the church parking lot. Always be mindful of the six-feet social distancing rules.

9. Attendance will be noted each week should it become necessary to inform parishioners of a potential health threat. If you, or someone close to you, develop COVID-19 symptoms in the days following your attendance at Mass, PLEASE phone/email the parish office immediately, in addition to contacting your doctor/public health.

Well, we feel this covers the basics. We understand this will be a strange experience for all but we once again ask for your cooperation and understanding as we navigate the guidelines to provide a safe experience for all.

If you have any questions about any of the rules/guidelines, please contact the parish office.

As we return to church, consider 1 Thessalonians 5:11 "Therefore, encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing." This verse is the guiding principle as we open our doors - we are working to protect ALL parishioners as best we can through patience, support and understanding.
