SPACE AVAILABLE TO ATTEND MASS: We would like to inform you that there is still space available to attend Mass at St. Mary's if you are comfortable in doing so or not at risk.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES WHILE ATTENDING MASS:

- -You are asked to maintain physical distancing,
- -To follow the ushers lead as they guide you and direct the Communion line as well as the exit procedure after Mass and
- -To remain seated in your pews until you receive the signal to proceed for Communion and to exit.
- -There will be no congregational singing and no sign of the peace.
- -Reception of Communion <u>in the hand</u> is strongly recommended for the time being.
- -Communicants are instructed to remove their gloves if applicable and to lower their masks while the person ahead of them is receiving Holy Communion

Know also that Bishop Bergie has announced a change in the reception of Communion as follows: When the Priest raises the Host and says "The Body of Christ": the Communicant is to, firstly, respond "Amen", THEN BOW as a sign of reverence, and THEN APPROACH to receive Communion.


